There is much excitement in Regina right now as there is a great opportunity in the coming months for people in our province to personally surrender to Jesus Christ. On June 12th and 13th there will be a Regina Look Up Celebration with Will Graham (the grandson of Billy Graham). Since we were able to successfully arrange for two reserve vans (15 passengers) from Muskowekwan to bring kids to the Kingdom Rock Vacation Bible School in Punnichy in August we began to explore if we could arrange for reserve vans for the upcoming event with Will Graham. We received approval not only to send people from Muskowekwan in the reserve vans but that they would also be able to stay in hotels overnight so they can attend both nights! On November 14th was the kickoff event and eleven people were brought up from Muskowekwan to be a part of the service and the reserve even provided supper before the event.

Ryan Tuck who works for the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association of Canada has connected with our church and we have been greatly encouraged by his heart for the Indigenous people. He came out to one of our church services on Muskowekwan in August and joined us at the Sing Regina event at Peculiar Nation in Pilot Butte. Our new associate pastor Omar White was asked to lead part of the prayer time and so Ryan asked Omar if he would be willing to help lead prayer at the Will Graham kickoff event. Omar did an excellent job in front of a crowd of over 1000 people!

Ryan came and preached at the Good News Chapel in November and shared about his childhood experience living on a reserve in the southern United States. He struggled with relating to God as his heavenly Father as he grew up without a positive father figure (a similar struggle of many people in our church).

Ryan and I are going to go on tour for a couple of days in January to see if we can get approval from other reserves to send people in their own reserve vans to the event in June (most reserves also have larger motorcoach buses). We ask for your prayers that God will grant us His favor with local leaders. It would also be amazing if an Indigenous related event could be planned leading up to the Celebration in June if God leads in this manner.
