EASTER VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL

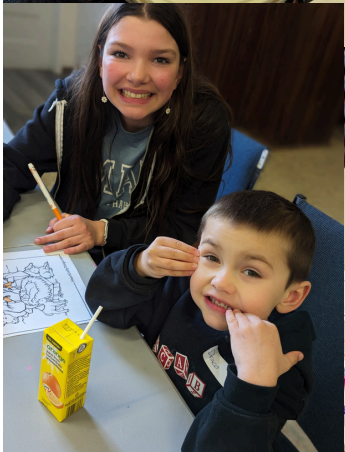
We partnered again with Regina Christian School and Gentle Road Church for an Easter VBS in North Central Regina. The high school students did a great job of leading the entire event.

- There continues to be opportunities for individuals or church groups to help prepare meals, donate food, help serve, or clean up. If you are able to come and help us out after your church service the meal starts usually around 12:15 pm.
- Pray that we will be able to find more partners for the church plant on Muskowekwan so that we can return to weekly services and expand our ministry on the reserve. If you would like to be a part of the reserve ministry we usually leave Regina around 11:30 am on Saturday and are back by around 6:30 pm. We also provide a small meal.
- Pray that God would provide more workers for the harvest. We're still uncertain of our long term direction related to an associate pastor. There is significant need as our church continues to grow in Regina as well as seeking a stable church plant on Muskowekwan First Nation.
- the church van has been needing more repairs- heater needed fixing, air conditioning needs repair this spring
- While many people in our congregation give sacrificially, we do not bring in enough financial support to meet our needs and must fundraise for the remainder of our budget. Financial support from those outside the church makes a big difference in our ministry. We praise God for all the individuals and churches who donate to support our ministry!
